By using Mailock, Beyond Encryption's encrypted email solution, You are agreeing to be bound by these Terms and Conditions and associated payment terms as detailed within your Proposal / Quotation together with conditions as outlined in our [Business User Licence Agreement](#), [Privacy Policy](#) and [Acceptable Use Policy](#).

If you are agreeing to these Terms and Conditions on behalf of Your Company, or another legal entity, You represent that You have the authority to bind such entity, and its Users who access the service through your account, to these Terms and Conditions.

These Business Terms and Conditions apply to the purchase and sale of any services between Us and You, to the exclusion of any other terms that you try to impose or incorporate, or which are implied by trade, custom, practice or course of dealing.

1) Commencement

This agreement shall come into force upon acceptance of these Terms & Conditions

2) Services

The description of the Services offered is set out in our Proposal / Quotation to You. In accepting the Proposal / Quotation and the pricing structure and payment methods therein, You acknowledge that You have not relied upon any statement, promise or other representations about the Services by Us. We reserve the right to make changes to the Specification of the Services as may be required from time to time to conform with any applicable safety or other statutory or regulatory requirements.

3) Payment

You accept by signing these Terms and Conditions that You shall pay the fees as noted within the Proposal / Quotation, by the due date and You also accept that if We have not received payment within 14 days after the due date then your access to all or part of the Services may be disabled.

4) Term and Termination

Unless terminated within the first 30 days, this agreement shall continue for 12 months (Initial Term) and shall automatically extend for 12-monthly periods (Extended Term) at the end of the Initial Term and at the end of each subsequent Extended Term. Either party may give written notice to the other party, not later than 90 days before the end of the Initial Term or the relevant Extended Term, to terminate this agreement.

5) Variation

No variation to this agreement shall be effective unless it is in writing and signed by both parties or their authorised representatives. We may make changes to the terms of this agreement from time to time and not less than three months prior written notice shall be given.
